DAY 1 HOME / DENVER

We drive north past the Sangre de Cristo Mountains and over Raton Pass into Colorado. We enjoy the scenery as we ride along the convergence of the Great Plains and the Rocky Mountains. We lodge one night in Denver.

DAY 2 BISON RANCH / WYOMING CB,L

We are in cowboy country now, as we visit the Terry Bison Ranch located on the Wyoming/Colorado border. We ride into the heart of the 30,000-acre ranch to see many of its 2,500 buffalo and other critters. Lunch is at the ranch. After crossing the Wyoming high desert, we reach the Black Hills of South Dakota, where we lodge three nights in Keystone.

DAY 3 MT. RUSHMORE / CRAZY HORSE B,D

Today we enjoy the awesome beauty of the Black Hills and take in its great attractions. Mount Rushmore's four famous presidents, the Borglum Historical Center, the on-going sculpting of Crazy Horse Mountain by the Ziolkowski family make for a memorable day. Tonight we return to Mt. Rushmore for the night-lighting ceremony.

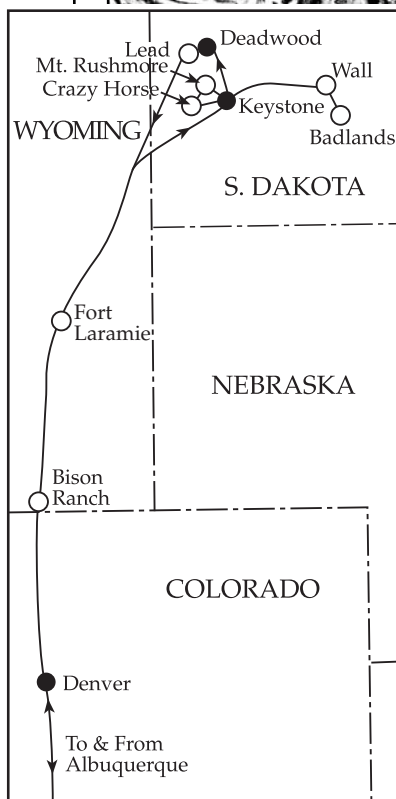
DAY 4 THE BADLANDS / BEARS B

We visit Badlands National Park, a geological wonder with its maze of buttes, canyons, and gullies formed by 37 million years of weathering and erosion. Near the Badlands we stop at Wall Drug Store, where "free ice water" has been offered since 1936! At Bear Country U.S.A. we drive through 250 acres of natural habitat, seeing lots of wildlife (especially the bears!) up close.

DAY 5 LEAD / DEADWOOD B

We take the scenic route through the Black Hills to Lead where we learn about the Black Hills gold rush at the Homestake Mine Visitors Center and the Living Map Theater. In nearby Deadwood, gambling is back, like in the boomtown days when Wild Bill Hickok was shot holding aces and eights. After a city tour we have free time to enjoy the original architecture, museums, and gambling. Tonight we see *The Trial of Jack McCall* in Deadwood where we lodge one night.
