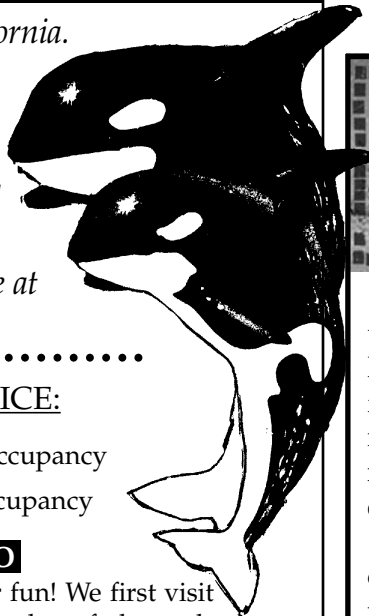


SAN DIEGO

DAY 1 HOME / SAN DIEGO

We fly to San Diego - headed for fun! We first visit Seaport Village, a charming complex of shops that reflects San Diego's harborside of a century ago. Then we cruise the peaceful waters of San Diego Bay to view the city skyline and Navy ships. We lodge four nights at the Bay Club Hotel located on Shelter Island with striking views of the surrounding bay and marinas.

DAY 2 CITY TOUR / HOTEL DEL CORONADO B,L

This morning we tour the city with a local guide, visiting the Gaslamp Quarter, downtown, the harborfront, Balboa Park, and Old Town. Then we drive over San Diego Bay on the Bay Bridge to Coronado Island and Hotel del Coronado, one of the world's most famous hotels. Its silhouette is unmistakable. This Victorian landmark of spires and dormers is the world's largest wood structure. After our luxurious lunch here, we have time to stroll its sandy beaches and enjoy the hotel's ambiance.

DAY 3 SEA WORLD / ANTHONY'S B,D

We enjoy the panoramic view of San Diego and its harbor from Point Loma's Cabrillo National Monument, then drive to Sea World, the world's finest marine life park. We see Shamu, dolphins, seals, otters, walruses, sharks, and penguins in a setting of beautiful flowers, tropical lagoons, and exotic birds. Seafood dinner at Anthony's tonight!

DAY 4 POMPEII EXHIBITION / MUSEUMS B

We have all day to enjoy the many museums of Balboa Park, the largest urban cultural park in the U.S. The highlight is *A Day in Pompeii* at the Natural History Museum. Other museums include the Reuben Fleet Science Center, the Air & Space Museum, the Automotive Museum, the Model Railroad Museum, the Museum of Art, the Museum of Man, and the Museum of Photographic Arts.

DAY 5 SAN DIEGO ZOO / FLY HOME B

At the Zoo, we take the guided bus tour of the Zoo's highlights and have time to visit our favorite animals. Then we fly home to Albuquerque with happy memories of our visit to lovely San Diego.

A Day in Pompeii at the Museum of Natural History takes us back in time to experience life and death in the Roman Empire's favorite vacation resort.
